## Directional Terms & Planes of the Body

Term	Description
Aboral	The end opposite the mouth of a radially symmetrical animal
Oral	The end containing the mouth of a radially symmetrical animal
Anterior	The head end: usually the end of a bilateral animal that meets the environment
Posterior	The tail end
Caudal	Toward the tail
<b>Cephalic/ Cranial</b>	Toward the head
Distal	Away from the point of attachment of a structure on the body (i.e. the toes are distal to the knee)
Proximal	Toward the point of attachment of a structure on the body (i.e. the hip is proximal to the knee)

Term	Description
Dorsal	The back of an animal; usually the upper surface; synonymous for <i>posterior</i> for animals that walk upright
Ventral	The belly of an animal; usually the lower surface; synonymous for <i>anterior</i> for animals that walk upright
Inferior	Below a point of reference (i.e. the mouth is inferior to the nose on the face)
Superior	Above the point of reference (i.e. the head is superior to the chest)
Lateral	Away from the plane that divides a bilateral animal into mirror images
Medial	On or near the plane that divides a bilateral animal into mirror images
